At the end: Give thanks to the Lord for his glorious Gospel. Praise to Christ our Lord.

Blessing of the palms

Almighty and everlasting God, may these palms [and branches] be for us a sign of Christ's victory over sin and death; and may we who have been baptised in his name, worship him as king, obey him as lord, and follow him in the way of the cross, which leads to eternal life. We ask this through the same lesus Christ our Lord.
